

# SAN ANTONIO CALLIGRAPHERS' GUILD

General Meeting 10-5-2023



The monthly meeting of the San Antonio Calligraphers' Guild was held on Thursday, October 5, 2023 at the Dwyer Center of the San Antonio Genealogical and Historical Society. The meeting was also presented via Zoom. President Laura Herold called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. A quorum of members attended the meeting.

## **Business Meeting:**

**President's Report:** Laura Herold reported that IAMPETH will hold their conference here in San Antonio next summer. She will send out information about it. Laura has been in touch with Ana and Luis from Capital City Scribes to see if they are willing to update our website. She will report after they meet.

**Vice-President's Report:** Leslie Winakur— no report for Awards and Memorials. She asked if we should proceed with Paul Freeman Awards this year.
